



COVID-19 WTSC GUIDELINES TO ALL PARENTS

Dear Parents,

As per NSW Department of Education guidelines, community language schools can resume for operations from Monday 1st June 2020. Accordingly, WTSC re-opened on 13th June 2020 for upto maximum of 100 people onsite as per the request of Girraween Public School.

We as Wentworthville Tamil Study Centre will adhere with Australian Health Protection Principal Committee (AHPPC) guidelines and advice from NSW Health. The guidelines are available here:

WTSC Principals have now decided to include Year 5 to resume for face to face learning on Saturday 22nd August 2020 and other classes will resume progressively.

We will provide an update before your child(ren) class(es) commence. We expect all other classes to continue with their online learning until further notifications.

As part of the community language schools, we are instructed to leave classrooms clean and tidy at the conclusion of each class. This will include using disinfectant to wipe down hard surfaces, including desks, cupboards, whiteboards, door handles, light switches, etc. The WTSC have engaged a professional cleaning company to carry out this task at the end of the day.

Please note the following,

- No parents are allowed on-site and if you wish to contact WTSC Admin/Principals/Teachers, please contact the office via info@wtsc.org.au or on +614 0864 5300.
- Access to school will be through Bando Road gate only. The Gilba Road gate is always closed.
- We have professional day cleaners who clean all high surfaces after the school operating hours.
- Teachers are equipped with the necessary cleaning products to ensure that surfaces and items used are sanitised.
- The principals, teachers, committee members and any personnel onsite would have completed "Infection Control Training – COVID 19" prior to school reopening.
- Any symptomatic child will be sent to the office and parents will be contacted immediately. Please do not send unwell children to school.
- There will be no assemblies.
- No refreshments provided during breaks. Children to bring their own food and water
- No water bubbler to be used.

FAQs

How do I drop off my child?

The Bando Road gate will be opened from 1.15pm for the students. We suggest that you plan trip ahead and allow extra time to cater for any unforeseen traffic due to drop offs.

There will be no adults/parents will be allowed to enter the school. There will be committee members at the entrance of Bando Road gate to ensure the safety of our students.

How do I pick up my child?

Children will be exiting through Bando Road gate. Please refer to the detailed map.



Please note, we need to do this well and safely. Please speak with your elderly parents or grandparents and let them know of this procedure and ensure you are socially distancing yourself from the other adults.

If you want to use the kiss and drop zone you must wait in your car for your child to come to you. You are not to park in the Kiss and Drop Zone.

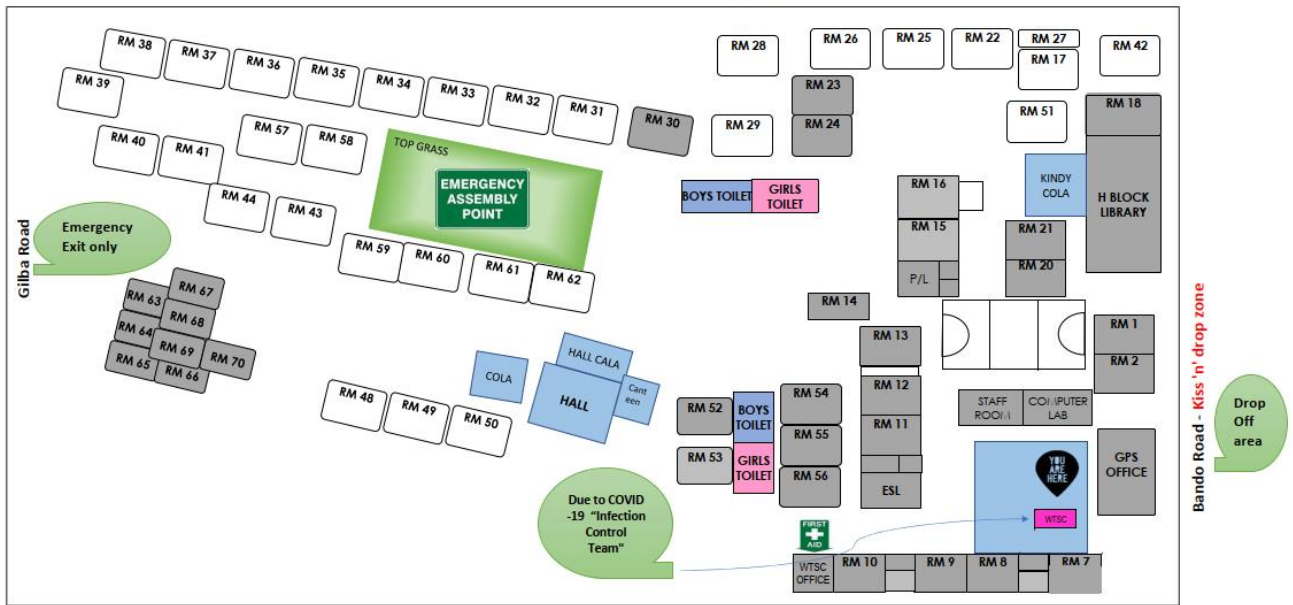
