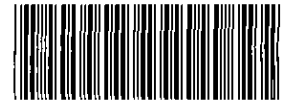



## Wentworthville Tamil Study Centre

### Changes to the Constitution

***Rule Number 13.(1) has been changed to read as follows:***

Subject in the case of the first members of the committee to Section 21 of the Act, the executive committee,

(i) in the event the school is run as a single session, shall consist of –

- (a) the office bearers of the centre; and
- (b) seven ordinary members, each of whom except referred in clause 3, shall be elected at the annual general meeting of the Centre every year.

(ii) in the event the school is run as two sessions, shall consist of –

- (a) the office bearers of the centre; and
- (b) six ordinary members, each of whom except referred in clause 3, shall be elected at the annual general meeting of the Centre every year.

***Rule Number 13.(2) has been changed to read as follows:***

(i) In the event the school is run as a single session, the office-bearers of the Centre shall be the following eight members:

- (a) the president;
- (b) the vice-president;
- (c) the treasurer;
- (d) the assistant treasurer;
- (e) the secretary;
- (f) the assistant secretary;
- (g) the principal; and
- (h) the vice-principal.

(ii) In the event the school is run as two sessions, the office-bearers of the Centre shall be the following twelve members:

- (a) the president;
- (b) two vice-presidents;
- (c) the treasurer;
- (d) two assistant treasurers;
- (e) the secretary;
- (f) two assistant secretaries;
- (g) the principal; and
- (h) two vice-principals

***Rule Number 14.(13) has been changed to read as follows:***

It shall be the responsibility of the outgoing members of the Executive Committee to ensure a smooth transfer of all responsibilities to the newly elected members of the Executive Committee who shall assume their responsibilities on the 1<sup>st</sup> of January the following year.

*The following two sub-sections {15.(7) and 15.(8)} have been added to Rule 15:*

15.(7) Assistant Treasurer:

- (a) assists the treasurer in all his duties;
- (b) represents the treasurer in his absence.

15.(8) Assistant Secretary:

- (a) assists the secretary in all his duties;
- (b) represents the secretary in his absence.
